### Pregnancy Centers

June 2025 marked the third anniversary of the Supreme Court's Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization decision. On June 5, Senator Cruz introduced a joint resolution to the U.S. Senate to designate June as Life Month. He reminded us that "life is not an accident, and it is not a coincidence. It is a joy and a blessing from God". Life is the foundation of every other right we hold dear. Without it, there can be no liberty, no prosperity, no pursuit of happiness. During his address, he stated "Walk into any pregnancy resource center in the country, and you will see these values in action: Volunteers counseling scared young mothers, shelves stocked with diapers and baby clothes and supplies, medical care offered without a dime of government funding." A culture where motherhood is supported, fatherhood is honored, and every child is welcomed into the world with love, not fear.
